Hood Habitat for Humanity's 7<sup>th</sup> Annual 'Home Sweet Home' Benefit Dinner & Auction coming up on Friday, April 25<sup>th</sup>. All of the proceeds will go directly towards helping fund the first phase of our new 22-unit condominium complex called Jubilee Commons, located in the Rockwood area of Gresham. The first 5 homes are scheduled to be completed this summer but Habitat needs the support from community members like you to help them reach their goal of raising \$200,000 at this event. Since its inception, Mt. Hood Habitat has enabled 38 adults and 53 children from East Multnomah and Clackamas Counties to build and own their own homes. The event will be emceed by Kelley Day of KOIN News 6 and includes dinner, a silent, live auction and of course, the feeling that you have made a difference for low income families who otherwise would not have the opportunity to own their own homes.
