Portland, Ore. (06/09/08) – The Portland ITT Technical Institute will be relocating to Cascade Station. The new, modern location will feature 11 class rooms, seven labs, and is conveniently located on the TriMet MAX Red Line (Mt. Hood Ave. station).

The relocation will be complete by September 2008.
